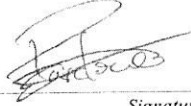

SUBJECT: PAROLE REQUEST

Dear Officer,

My second court Immigration Hearing just occurred this day on March 6th 2025 at 1.30 pm precisely and my Bond request has been denied by the judge because I am in withholding only proceedings, I decided to don't appeal the decision and just ^{to} accept it. I decided on this date which has a significance for me to move forward with my case. The Judge immediately explained to me the reason why he can not accept my Bond Request but he told me that I was eligible to request Parole and he recommended me to require to my Ice Officer to be released from Custody. I will not asking to my ICE Officer for this request, I am asking directly to you and people above my deportation officer. My ICE Officer didn't was honest with me and lied to me so much times since the beginning of the process saying as example that I wasn't eligible for " parole ". It is a lie because I just was in meeting with the judge this afternoon and the meeting interview has been recorded. My ICE Officer, as same than my French Council of Miami and Atlanta never wanted to help me during the process and do all they can do in Disaccording to the law and by using some lies to keep me as long as possible inside the Custody because they know that I am suffering each day prevented of my freedom and for a reason unknown, they want to ^{or} prosecute me. If they wanted to help me ^{or} were in care of my welfare, I would be free since long time ago... So right now I am going to list all the reasons for whose I should be released from Custody:

I have a mailing and a residence address in Atlanta, Georgia [REDACTED] where I was doing all the right things with my case manager to be able to work as soon as possible, I received an authorization, work permit form approved from my USCIS Account and I was supposed to receive my work permit card into this same address in Atlanta. I also applied with Delivery Dash company which just was waiting for my work permit card to approve my registration. I am also member of the Church Christian community of this same Shelter [Atlanta Mission] who came to pick me up each Sunday to going to the Church and I created very strong friendship within this community.

I have a medical issue since 2020 and it cannot be resolved only by providing me medication. I need my freedom and without my freedom I will never be able to healing my depression and I know this issue will get worst and I have already spent couple of months inside the Custody, prevented of my Freedom, which is included in my human rights. Being locked up for several months without getting any free day outside the Custody is very painful for me and I am not afraid to talk about emotional torture because Human is not an animal and even the animals need their own freedom, I am not a danger for the Us community and I don't need to prove it because my criminal record is already known from your service. I was free from October 17th until January 10th and I never attempted to the safety of anybody. These last two months have been very hard, mentally and I used sometimes to losing hope. I already made 3 hunger strikes and I don't want to hurt my self anymore. I just want to be free because I deserve it. Freedom is not an option but a fundamental right of anybody which didn't commit any crime or felony according to the United States Constitution. I am in USA since 5 months ago already and I know a lot about this country, I learned a lot and I read a lot, including the laws of immigration. I came legally by plane to the Airport entrance of Fort-Lauderdale, I didn't cross the border illegally and my Visa was not suppose to be cancel under a lie. I never said that I wished to work illegally in United States, I never said that. My touristic Visa was supposed to ending on January 13th (3 days after that I have been arrested at home, taking my breakfast) I also paid 400 dollars an American company located in Los Angeles [ENI Express] to get allowed to opening a bank account, obtaining a license driver and renting an apartment I was just waiting the documentation which was supposed to be approved in February 2025. I also applied for a U-Visa in December 2024 and the process is still on pending. I am not going to Flee DHS and I have always advised USCIS of my changing of address in United States.

For all the reasons listed above, I kindly asking you to release me from Custody, if you need additional support or any evidence, I kindly asking you to mailing me all the recommendations to Stewart Detention, 146 CCA ROAD, PO BOX 248. I am also available and at disposal of the US Justice for any additional hearing or any Fear claim interview.

Dear Judge ,

This present letter will be used to complete my previous declaration but more specifically at this time about the ICE Officers of Fort-Lauderdale Airport and even these officers were very kind to release me under my own recognizance i cannot accept that my Visa has been canceled under a lie , i cannot accept to have been threatened and i cannot accept to have been arrested at home almost 3 months later without even having violated any laws of the country .

Custom Officers of Fort-Lauderdale said first of all on October 16th 2024 that i wanted to work illegally in United States and that it was a good reason to cancel my touristic Visa , However during my recorded audition i never said that i wanted to work illegally and i never said that i would attempt to work illegally , you can use this recorded audition as proof of lies whose these officers made to cancel illegally my Visa.

Then the chief of managment of this unity decided to put the pressure on me because i refused to get into the plane , it is included in my human rights , to defend myself , and the country which they wanted to send me back (Dominican Republic) is dangerous for me , i was persecuted there by a criminal organization of drug dealers who kept my french passport and made a lot of research about me . They know exactly where i used to live in France , what kind of things i usually did when i was there . Avignon , the city where i come from in France is not very big and they won't have any problem to find me there if you send me back to this country . France is well smaller than USA and anybody can find me there .

I don't want to get the ICE Officers in trouble with the justice even they threatened me because they were so nice to getting me released from custody after only 2 days and i very appreciated it . ICE Officers of Atlanta don't have been as nice and they mistreated me by denying all my human rights since january 10th . I remember that they refused to let me call any lawyer. I have lost my bank account and when the judge will release me from custody , i will be lost without even a bank account . It is why I am kindly asking you , with some help from social workers , to helping me when i will get released from custody . I just want a normal life , an apartment and a job , that's it . I am not interested about money or even power . I just want to live my life as a humble people and to have some projects , here in United States .

Dear Judge ,

I have got a good time in Florida , i dwelt first of all approximately 3 weeks inside Bloundroad shelter in Pompano Beach . During The day i was going to the beach by walking approximately 2 hours and sometimes , i used to take the bus to get to Fort-Lauderdale . One day , Paul a man with a broken back was passing through the road with his very nice expensive car and just told me : " Hey Bro , how are you doing ? I need some help to clean my house , do you need some cash ? " Without any hesitation i said " yes of course ! " It was not about working but just helping this man to cleaning his house . He used to pay me around 30 or 40 dollards each days and i was very happy for helping him .

Unfortunately , Paul is gay and he wanted to give me some massages , saying that he would pay me for that . I refused , i am not gay ! I only want relationship with the women , not the men . I was a bit frustrated to receive this kind of proposal from a man and i decided to stop helping this man after 2 weeks . Beach is very nice there and it was very pleasant for me to lying on the sand and relaxing under the sun when i wasn't helping the man ! I very enjoyed the time which i got there , in Florida . 3 weeks after i have gone to Miami and i dwelt inside an hostel which i booked on internet . It was inside this hostel that i met my first American friend who made me visting Miami and its Areas . He knows well the city and got me into very nice places where we ate some sandwich and where we drunk some coffee .

This friend got in trouble with alchool and he bacame addict . He used to mix every day , his vodka with a gatherade drink and to don't get in trouble with the police , he used always the bottle of gatherade with inside the alchool which he used to hide . He told me that one time in Philadelphia , some kids stopped front of him and shot him with the guns just for their own pleasure...He got an arm out of functions . Inside this hostel where i used to sleep , i got a very bad surprise one morning when i was sleeping...I got wok up by a very strange man , who was attempting to touching me during my sleep . I was very angry at this time but i decided to keep the control of myself and i didn't hurt this man despite he had done . I told him that he had to give me 100 dollards or i would tell everything to the police ! He gave me the money and i dealt with it , i didn't tell anything !

I submitted to you a U-Visa request form in December 2024 and i regret that the process be still on pending because i am in Custody , which one of Detention Center of Lumpkin since January 10th for a lack of legal immigration status , i don't understand why my U-Visa didn't get approve yet because i had already my Fear Claim with the Custom Officers of Fort-Lauderdale on October 17th , so if you are not able to approve this request as soon as possible to permit me to get out from Custody , could you please mailing as quick as possible to my new residence address , which one of the custody , mentioned above within this present letter , a documentation to get the citizenship of United States and a documentation request form to apply as quick as possible for another Visa which one will be usefull to get out from the jail because i have already spent more than 2 months inside the Custody because my French Officer of Miami made a lie saying that i harassed her and threatened her in the only point to harm me and emotionally it is starting to getting really painful , i am suffering and struggling with depression since 2020 when my mother past away and my depression get worst each day , inside the jail .

If you are not able to take any action with my Case i kindly asking you to mailing me all the recommendation , also , as i have a work permit authorization approved , i kindly asking you to mailing it to the Immigration Court of Lumpkin to 146 CCA Road to make them acknowledging about it and i want you also to mailing me a copy of this documentation and my work permit card also to the Custody of Lumpkin : Po Box 248 by mentioning my Alien registration number

This present letter will be printed and a copy will be relayed to DHS , to the organization of attorney which i solicited for my case also and another copy will be relayed to the Immigration Judge as proof of jurisdiction requirement

Dear Inspector ,

I mailed you approximately 2 weeks ago a parole request and this present letter will be use as proof and to complete the previous declaration . My USCIS account number is [REDACTED] and you will be able to check with my account that i made all the right things to get legal in the country and that my U-Visa is well still on pending . I am in Withholding of Removal since October 17th 2024 and i still don't have got my fear interview with the immigration judge . I understand that the process takes a bit of time and that i am not alone to apply for azylum . You have to understand also that i am in custody since january 10th 2025 and that it is becoming very difficult for me to be prevented of my freedom as much time .

My French Officer who works in Miami said that i harassed her but it is wrong , i effectively sent approximately 40 emails since may or june 2024 to seeking some assistance but we can not talking about harassment about this case . This Officer should use her heft and her responsibilities to assist me with my immigration issue instead of getting me in trouble with the authorities . Lies whose have for only point to persecute anyone and to get him into a custody can be considered as a crime in United States , or at least a violation of the constitution . It is why i decided to contact Fulton County superior court of Atlanta and which one of Miami-Dade Clerk of court because i should not have being arrested at home on this day while i was taking my breakfast without even violating any laws of the country or attempting to the safety of anybody

The Immigration Court of Lumpkin lacks of jurisdiction because my ICE Officer refuse to relay me all the documentation which he has got about my case . I need my criminal record to prove to the judge that i am not a danger for US community , i need a medical declaration to prove him that i have well a disability about my mental health : Depression . I need also my work permit approved by USCIS and i would like also a copy of my fear claim witch i made in Fort-Lauderdale on October 17th to prove him that i never said that i want to attempt to working illegally in United States as the Ice Officers of Fort-Lauderdale Airport pretended .

I'm kindly asking you to mail me all the required documentation as soon as possible , i am also asking you an alternative to my detention if you consider that i am not eligible for parole .

Dear Officer ,

I still don't understand , what am I doing in Custody and why have I to spend so much time inside this place , all this time which has been stolen from my life and it has already been 66 Days since the ICE Officers arrested me at home , in Atlanta , for nothing . Just because I have a lack of status available regarding my immigration case , it is what the Officers of ICE told me but they didn't tell me about any crime or felony , so if I don't have any charge on my criminal record I still don't understand how is possible that I spend so much time inside the custody without any possibility of defending myself excepting by mailing letters. I Don't think that the protagonists of the Democratic United States constitution's establishment have been though the Democracy like this and if anybody can get to the jail or custody for any reason can we still talk about democracy ?

I don't know what to do , the judge scheduled me another hearing on April 28th and it will be the fourth one ! I am in With Holding of Removal since October 17th and the Judge denied my Bond request on March 6th 2025, he said also that he doesn't have the jurisdiction to get me released under my own recognizance but fortunately I know that it's not truth , I am not saying he's a liar but he is wrong : Judge has the jurisdiction to decide in United States , not the Government . I don't want to spend several months of my life in Custody for nothing . Do am I so dangerous for US community for keeping me locked up as an animal ? Did I violate any law when I quietly took my breakfast at home and got arrested by ICE ? Did any Judge approve the decision to get me into the Custody ? Did a judge charge me with any crime or felony ?

My USCIS number of account is [REDACTED] you will see that I have done all the right things , I have already applied for a U-Visa in December 2024 and I never got any answer from USCIS , I don't know what the hell is going on , but I want it to stop , right now it is enough and I have a mental health disability : Depression . After 66 Days in Custody I want to get released as quick as possible , I cannot deal anymore with this situation . I want to recover my Freedom and I don't have to wait as much time , my next hearing is on April 28th but Freedom is a fundamental right of human being , even if I don't have the American citizenship yet , I deserve to be free and I deserve to be happy ,

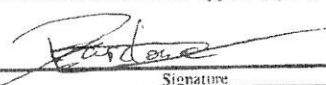
