PETITIONER'S STATUS REPORT

On April 2, 2026, an Immigration Judge (IJ) conducted a bond hearing pursuant to this Court's March 25, 2026 Order and ordered Petitioner released from immigration custody on his own recognizance. *See Exhibit 1.* Petitioner does not intend to challenge the constitutionality of the bond hearing. However, the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) reserved appeal, which is due to the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) on or before May 4, 2026. In light of this, this Court should defer entry of judgment and closure of this case until the appeal period has expired.
