I, Liubov Kokoreva, a citizen of Russia, respectfully submit this petition to the federal court requesting release from immigration detention. My continued detention violates my rights under the U.S. Constitution and immigration law.

I arrived in the United States on February 8, 2025, together with my husband, Dmitrii Gukovskii (A-Number: A-[REDACTED]), in search of protection from persecution. We were both apprehended on February 10 and placed into immigration custody. After our detention, we were separated: I was transferred to the Eloy Detention Center in Arizona, and my husband was transferred to the Imperial Regional Detention Facility in California.

Since the beginning of my detention, I have not been provided a credible fear interview, which is a required step in the asylum process under INA 208(a)(1). This law clearly states that any individual physically present in the U.S., regardless of how they entered, has the right to apply for asylum.

Instead of receiving a credible fear interview, I was subjected only to a Convention Against Torture (CAT) interview on February 25, 2025, despite not being the principal applicant. My husband, Dmitrii, is the principal applicant, but he has also been denied the opportunity to defend himself: he was not provided a follow-up interview, his case has not been referred to court, and ICE officers routinely threaten him with immediate deportation.

Neither I nor my attorney have received the results of my CAT interview, despite multiple formal requests. This directly violates 8 C.F.R. 208.31(g), which states that even after a negative CAT determination, an individual is entitled to review before an immigration judge.

Throughout our detention, both my husband and I have repeatedly been told by ICE officers that we will be deported at any moment. These constant threats have placed us under extreme psychological stress and fear.

There have already been two attempts to deport me.

The first attempt occurred in April 15, 2025, but I refused to sign any removal documents or give consent, and I was allowed to remain in detention.

The second attempt occurred during the night of May 5, 2025, around 3:00 AM. Again, I did not sign anything and was only left in the facility after I emotionally pleaded with the officers. I was again told that my husband would be deported soon and that I should "be prepared".

That same night, my husband was taken for deportation. During transport, he suffered a severe panic attack and was in an extremely distressed state. He was later informed that his flight had been canceled, and he was returned to the detention center.

My detention began on February 10, 2025, the day we were apprehended at the border.

As of May 5, 2025, I have been detained for 85 days. On May 8, 2025, I will reach 90 days in detention. Under the U.S. Supreme Court decision *Zadvydas v. Davis*, 533 U.S. 678 (2001), continued beyond 90 days without a real prospect of removal is unconstitutional and unlawful.

Request to the Court:

1. Declare my detention unlawful.
2. Order ICE to:
  - Either conduct a credible fear interview and refer my case to immigration court,
  - Or release me under supervision or on bond.
3. Apply the same relief to my husband, Dmitrii Gukovskii, who remains in detention under similar circumstances – denied access to protection, without court proceedings, and under continuous threat of deportation.

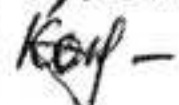
Legal Authorities and Precedents Cited:

- INA 208(a)(1): Grants the right to apply for asylum regardless of manner of entry.
- 8 C.F.R. 208.31(g): Requires immigration judge review following a negative CAT determination.
- *Zadvydas v. Davis*, 533 U.S. 678 (2001): Establishes that prolonged post-removal detention beyond 90 days is unconstitutional if removal is not reasonably foreseeable.
- Fifth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution (Due Process Clause): Protects against arbitrary detention without fair legal process.

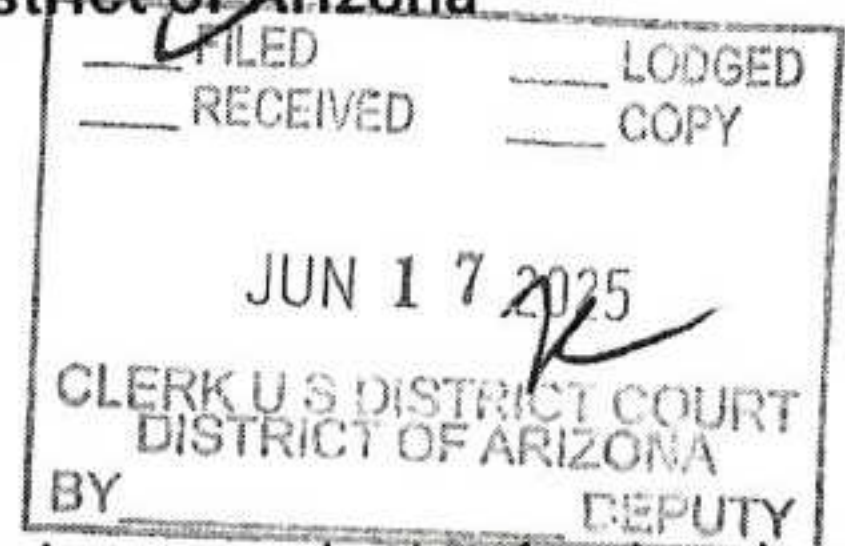

**IN ADDITION TO SUPPORT OF MY HABEAS CORPUS PETITION**

This petition is filed on behalf of Liubov Kokoreva (A# [REDACTED]), who is currently detained and unable to submit filings directly due to restrictions and delays in the detention facility. The facts and statements contained herein are based on her own account and personal experience, as communicated by her. This is submitted in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 2242 as an emergency and urgent supplement in light of four attempted deportations and the deteriorating psychological condition of the petitioner due to trauma and the danger of return to her country of origin.

My name is Liubov Kokoreva, A# [REDACTED]. I arrived in the United States on the night of February 8–9, 2025, together with my husband, Dmitrii Gukovskii, A# [REDACTED]. We crossed the border at the Calexico–Mexicali port of entry and immediately applied for political asylum, presenting valid international passports.

We were presented with several documents on an electronic tablet and forced to sign them 3 to 5 times without being allowed to see their contents, despite our repeated requests. These signatures are now being used against us, even though we declared our intention to seek asylum at the border. These actions violate 8 C.F.R. § 208.30(d), which requires that every applicant be informed of their rights and the contents of documents when seeking asylum.

On Saturday, June 7, 2025, a series of events began that I perceived as physical and psychological abuse. I was called to the intake area at the Eloy immigration detention center in Arizona and told to pack. I and other people were taken to a very cold room with benches, where we waited until 10 PM just to see an ICE officer, who presented deportation papers. I refused to sign them, explaining that I have an open case in federal court, that my husband is awaiting a master hearing in immigration court, and that I am included in his I-589 application. The ICE officer shouted that he didn't care and that I would be deported anyway because, according to him, I had a final order of removal. He wrote on the paper: "refused to sign" — and gave me two copies of documents. One of them said I had a 5-year ban, with my electronic signature and fingerprint already on it. I do not know how or where these were added. I did not knowingly sign anything, except once electronically at the border, but even then we were not allowed to see what we were signing. Therefore, I consider it invalid. The second document said I had a deportation order.

The intake officers subjected me to psychological pressure, threatening that immigration officers would come and forcibly deport me, saying no one would care that I am a woman, and that things would be worse for me if I didn't comply. I asked to call my attorney — they denied my request. Then they began putting chains on everyone — wrists, ankles, and waist. I refused, but four women used force to put chains on me. I did not resist physically, I just didn't want to move. They forced me into a solitary cage on the bus. It was around 1–2 AM.

We were taken to Phoenix Airport, where we were kept on the bus for a long time and then placed on a plane. The flight was delayed. We were told there were no available beds at the facility where I was being sent, so I was returned to Eloy. Again — cold holding, processing, and only around 3 PM was I returned to my unit. I was exhausted, frightened, and had gone nearly 24 hours without sleep. I received no medical or psychological assistance, which violates 8 C.F.R. § 1208.4(b) and the ICE Performance-Based National Detention Standards (PBNDS).

During the night from Monday to Tuesday, around 2 AM, I was woken up again, placed in chains, and told I was being transferred. Once again, I was not allowed to make a call, even though this is required by ICE standards and violates the 5th Amendment Due Process Clause. I was taken to the airport and flown to Dallas, Texas. There, I and other people were taken to the Prairieland Detention Center. We were told processing would take 12 hours. We were placed in a small, freezing room designed for 1–2 people, but there were about 15 of us. The toilet was not separated. We sat on the floor. We were not given blankets or allowed to wash or make phone calls. No one responded to our knocks and pleas. It was torturous. We were told we would all be deported by charter on Thursday.

I spent a day and a half in this room without being processed or allowed to sleep. My relatives and attorney had no idea where I was during this time — in the system, I was still listed as being in Eloy. I felt fear, helplessness, and horror at the inevitability of deportation. I had no way to protest. It felt like kidnapping. I had barely slept in three days. My joints began to ache, my hands trembled, and my eye twitched. I began experiencing panic attacks. This was accompanied by severe anxiety, stress, and emotional exhaustion.

On the morning of June 12, they began preparing everyone for deportation. I was placed in chains like the others, but at the exit, a female officer, hearing my name, said: "this one stays." They removed the chains, and I was returned to my unit around 2–3 PM. All the others — about 50 people — were taken away.

At this point, I remain in a state of fear and panic. I am not being told what is happening. I do not know whether there will be a fifth attempt to deport me to the country I fled, where I face danger.

Based on the foregoing, I respectfully request that this Court:

1. Immediately stop my deportation;
2. Accept this statement as part of my habeas corpus petition and enter me into the judicial system, consolidating my case with my husband's, as we have filed and received confirmation of a joint I-589 asylum application;
3. Consider releasing both me and my husband under order of supervision or humanitarian parole (INA § 212(d)(5)(A));
4. If release of both of us is not possible, I request at least my own release or transfer to the same facility where my husband, Dmitrii Gukovskii (A# [REDACTED]), is held — the Imperial Detention Center — so we can fully support each other and effectively defend ourselves in court. Being held in different states complicates our attorney's work and hinders our joint legal process.

We are a peaceful, honest, law-abiding young family seeking asylum in the United States from threats in our country of origin. We have a reliable sponsor. We pose no danger to society. All we ask is for our rights to be respected and to be allowed to remain together while defending our case.

I, Liubov Kokoreva (A# [REDACTED]), hereby affirm that all events described above are true and accurate to the best of my knowledge and based on my personal experience. I understand that providing false statements to the Court is a crime, and I submit this declaration under penalty of perjury pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746.

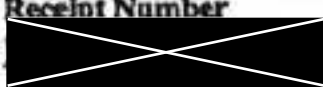

This letter refers to your Form I-589, Application for Asylum and for Withholding of Removal, filed on 05/09/2025.

Department of Homeland Security (DHS) records indicate that you were issued a Form I-862, Notice to Appear (NTA), and Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR) records indicate that your NTA was filed and docketed with the immigration court after U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) received your Form I-589. The asylum office is forwarding your Form I-589 to the appropriate immigration court. The date that USCIS received your Form I-589 is considered the filing date for purposes of the one-year filing deadline. At this time, you are not required to file Form I-589 with the immigration court. The forwarding of your Form I-589 includes any dependents included on your Form I-589 who are listed above (if applicable).

Once the immigration court receives your Form I-589, you will be informed by mail at the address that you provided of the date, time, and location of your court hearing.

Please include your full name, alien number (A-number) listed above, and your current address on any correspondence with USCIS or the immigration court.

You may remain in the United States until your asylum application is decided. If you wish to leave the United States while your application is pending, you must obtain advance parole or, for Temporary Protected Status (TPS) recipients, approval of Form I-512T, Authorization for Travel by a Noncitizen to the United States (sometimes referred to as MTINA TPS travel authorization), from USCIS or you may be considered to have abandoned your asylum application.

**Change of Address:**

You must report a change of address to USCIS within 10 days of moving by following the instructions on the How to Change Your Address webpage (<https://www.uscis.gov/addresschange>). Changing your address with the U.S. Postal Service will not change your address with USCIS.

Because you have been placed in removal proceedings, you must also notify the Immigration Court within five days of any change of address by completing Form EOIR-33, *Alien's Change of Address Form/Immigration Court*, and submitting the Form EOIR-33 to the Immigration Court where your proceedings have been referred. Form EOIR 33 is available on the Department of Justice website at [www.justice.gov/eoir/eoirforms/eoir33/ICdr33.htm](http://www.justice.gov/eoir/eoirforms/eoir33/ICdr33.htm).

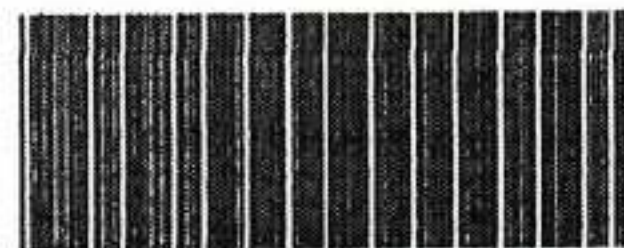
