The United States just received Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, which was filed at 4:40 p.m. and purports to schedule a hearing for tomorrow morning at 9:00 a.m. with Judge Oberto. The United States also received Plaintiff's non-consent to Magistrate jurisdiction and the assignment of District Judge Sheriff to this case. The United States also called Plaintiff's counsel and confirmed they unilaterally selected the hearing date for tomorrow and it was not pre-cleared with the court (or this counsel).

Given the foregoing, the United States understands no hearing is actually scheduled to occur at 9:00 tomorrow morning and thus will not appear. The United States further understands Judge Sheriff may screen this matter and/or set a briefing schedule on the TRO application. Because the motion was filed on the eve of a holiday weekend, the United States requests at least six court days (10 calendar days) to respond. Given Plaintiff's alleged urgency, it is expected to waive a reply. Counsel is available for hearing the following week if the court wants one.
