NOTICE

In accordance with the July 7, 2025 Order of this Court, the government advises the Court that the Dallas Field office for Enforcement and Removal Operations is working on Petitioner's removal and will continue to do so pending the resolution of the Petitioner's motion for a preliminary injunction and the habeas petition. However, it will take several weeks, if not more, to secure travel documents such that Defendants believe this litigation will likely conclude before the documents are obtained. If the government does obtain removal documents before this litigation concludes, it will provide Petitioner's counsel and the Court with at least three days' notice before moving Petitioner outside the Court's jurisdiction.
