Advisory to the Court

Respondents file this Advisory to update the Court on the status of Petitioner's physical removal from the United States. While subject to an expedited removal order and detained in ICE custody on a mandatory basis under 8 U.S.C. § 1225(b), Petitioner, *pro se*, filed this habeas petition on or about July 14, 2025. ECF No.1. ICE had already obtained a travel document for Petitioner on or about March 25, 2025. *Id.* On July 16, 2025, Petitioner was successfully removed from the United States to Ethiopia and is no longer in ICE custody. *See* Ex. A (Form I-205).
