**FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS, AND RECOMMENDATION
OF THE UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

Petitioner Vatsana Nouansisouhak, currently held in the custody of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) at the Prairieland Detention Center, a facility in this district, has filed an Emergency Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus (Dkt. No. 2 (“Petition” or “Pet.”)) and an Emergency Motion for Temporary Restraining Order (“TRO”) and/or Preliminary Injunction (Dkt. No. 4) (“Motion for Injunctive Relief” (“Mot. Inj.”)). This case has been automatically referred to the undersigned magistrate judge for pretrial management under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b) and a standing order of reference. (*See* Dkt. No. 1.)

Nouansisouhak seeks a preliminary injunction to require his immediate release from immigration detention, arguing there has been no change in circumstances and no individual assessment specific to Nouansisouhak that would make his removal reasonably foreseeable. (*See generally* Mot. Inj.) On August 29, 2025, Respondents filed a response to the Motion for Injunctive Relief (Dkt. No. 8
