As a person with anxiety based hypertension, it is important for me to receive medication as my diastolic goes above one hundred and ten which can lead to stroke. For the time I've been at the facility I've been complaining of chest pain and throat tightness and attempt to receive my medications on a daily basis. At times I may be called to different parts of the facility or go to recreation in the morning prior to the arrival of medication.

If I miss my meds. It's difficult or close to impossible to get the medication. I also have spinal stenosis and Kerataconus a degenerative eye condition where I wear specially made contact so I can see. I came to the facility with those contacts, yet it's difficult to receive new ones that I've had sent in. I also receive epidurals for the spinal stenosis. At this facility certain staff present issues to prevent me from receiving adequate care. I'm unable to see adequately past ten feet ahead. I am unable to receive my epidurals and now it's becoming difficult to receive my hypertension and pain medications.

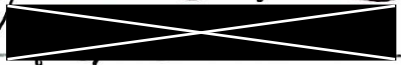
I just spoke to a nurse Williams who refused to give me medication because "you went for the yard" You should have gotten them first. I'm unsure of how I was meant to get them. If I didn't see or know she was there? The last time I tried to get them prior to going out I was told I needed to wait till everyone else got theirs. This seems to be a vindictive and personal thing.

I ask the honorable court to have me released so I can acquire adequate medical care. Constant chest pains and anxiety will lead to a cardiac arrest or stroke.

There is no reasonable foreseeable change for removal and the longer I'm here the worst it will be for me.

Conclusion

As a detainee I have no control of my ability to have my medical treatment. And it violates my 14th amendment rights to equal protection of the law. I either should be treated adequately or released to have adequate care.
