ORDER

15 Petitioner filed this action under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 challenging his immigration
16 detention on the basis that his placement in adult immigration detention when he turned 18
17 was unlawful. Petitioner also challenged his detention as potentially indefinite and argued
18 he is entitled to a bond hearing. Further, petitioner filed a motion for injunctive relief and
19 an order seeking discovery.

20 Thereafter, petitioner filed an amended petition challenging his immigration
21 detention on the grounds that there is no possibility he will be removed to Afghanistan even
22 if he is ultimately ordered removed to that country, his placement in immigration detention
23 is arbitrary and capricious in violation of the Administrative Procedure Act, and his
24 detention is unlawful because he is being denied a bond hearing before a neutral
25 decisionmaker. The parties filed a stipulated motion to stay discovery, which is granted.
26 Because the motion for injunctive relief relates to the original petition, which was
27 superseded by the amended petition, the motion for injunctive relief is denied as moot.

28 Finally, the court refers this matter to a magistrate judge for a report and

1 recommendation.

2 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

3 (1) Petitioner's motion for temporary restraining order and preliminary
4 injunction (Doc. 3) is **denied as moot**.

5 (2) The parties' motion to stay discovery (Doc. 21) is **granted**.

6 (3) Petitioner's motion to seal (Doc. 24) is **granted**. The documents lodged at
7 Doc. 25 shall be filed under seal. This order shall not be sealed.

8 (4) This matter is referred to Magistrate Judge Camille D. Bibles pursuant to
9 Rules 72.1 and 72.2 of the Local Rules of Civil Procedure for further proceedings and a
10 report and recommendation.
