Petitioner, through counsel, filed a habeas petition with this Court on or about September 18, 2025. ECF No. 1. On September 23, 2025, Petitioner filed a Motion for Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) and/or Preliminary Injunction. ECF No. 3. On the same day, this Court ordered Respondents to file a response by 12pm CST today, September 29, 2025. ECF No. 4.

Petitioner remains in ICE custody as of the time of this filing. The undersigned AUSA is working jointly with the Department of Justice Office of Immigration Litigation to secure Petitioner's release from custody as soon as possible in light of his claim to temporary protected status. Respondents will file a status update with this Court upon Petitioner's release from custody, or Respondents will comply with any Court order to provide status updates in the interim.
