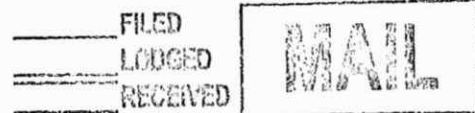

The Plaintiff Tareq Ziad Fouad Zakarneh” “Tareq”, on August ,12,2025 got an order from the BIA with prejudice denying his right to reopen his case to based on change country condition under 8 C.F.R 1003.2(c)(1), defendant represented by the Department of Justice and the Department of Homeland security with prejudiced fail to compromise with Tareq motions and reopen his case to bring change country conditions and new facts that has been discovered, the defendant should open the case in Tareq favor and give Tareq the chance to reexamine inadmissible evidence that the defendant presented to the agency of the BIA, Tareq moved to sue the two agencies in district court because it has more Jurisdiction than the Ninth circuit for an evidentiary hearing, the ninth circuit can’t accept more evidence than whats coming at the administrations record the ninth circuit in different case for *Zakarenh v.
