UNOPPOSED MOTION TO STAY BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Counsel for Petitioner and counsel for Respondents have conferred regarding the status of this matter. Subsequent to the filing of the Petition and Motions pending before the Court, Petitioner was transferred out of Camp 57 to a detention center in Arizona, where he is now seeking relief from his alleged imminent removal in the immigration courts. To afford Petitioner the opportunity to pursue his request for relief in that forum, and in light of the impacts such rulings and his transfer will likely have on this litigation, counsel for Petitioner and counsel for Respondents respectfully move this Court to hold the briefing schedule deadlines in this matter in abeyance until the relevant immigration proceedings are concluded.
