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PETITIONER'S STATUS UPDATE REGARDING
BOND REDETERMINATION HEARING

Norma Lucina GUZMAN SALDANA (hereinafter, "Petitioner"), through her attorney of record, Jose R. Jordan, Esq. (hereinafter, "Present Counsel"), hereby provides the court with an update regarding the status of her hearing for bond redetermination.

On or about November 4, 2025, Petitioner had her first post-*habeas* petition/temporary restraining order (hereinafter, "TRO") application regarding her hearing for bond redetermination. On the date thereof, however, she withdrew said motion without prejudice. Petitioner's reason for so doing was solely attributable to the immigration judge's (hereinafter, "IJ's") indicating that he was inclined to deny her release on bond (again) unless she withdrew the motion in question and re-filed it with proof that the District Attorney's Office (hereinafter, "DA's Office") has not filed any charges against her in connection with an alleged recent arrest for domestic violence. Petitioner then advised the IJ that she would re-file her bond motion with the immigration court as soon as possible after she is able to obtain the requested evidence. Accordingly, Petitioner hereby renews her request that the court neither deny nor dismiss her *habeas* petition and preliminary injunction, respectively, until at the very least the IJ adjudicates her renewed request for bond redetermination.

CONCLUSION

Based on the foregoing, Petitioner prays for the requested relief.
