6 On November 19, 2025, the parties, through counsel, met and conferred by

9 temporary restraining order and provided the grounds for the anticipated motion pursuant
10 to Local Rule 7-3. Counsel for Respondents stated that they would oppose Petitioner's
11 motion.

12 Petitioner anticipates filing his motion for reconsideration on or before November
13 26, 2025. The parties therefore respectfully request that the Court not set any deadlines
14 with respect to the Petition until the District Court issues its decision on Petitioner's
15 motion for reconsideration. Instead, the parties respectfully suggest that that the Court
16 issue an order requiring them to file a further status report within 14 days of issuance of
17 the District Court's decision on the reconsideration motion.
