PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO RETRACT PREVIOUSLY FILED HABEAS PETITION

On November 2, 2025, Plaintiff filed an amended Habeas petition challenging his detention.

The Court granted the petition on November 13, 2025, ordering the government to provide Plaintiff with a standard bond hearing before an Immigration Judge within 14 days. Plaintiff was provided a bond hearing on November 20, 2025, at which time he was denied release on bond, based on the Immigration Judge's conclusion that the Plaintiff was a danger to the community.

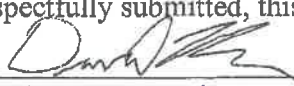
Upon denial of release on bond, Plaintiff decided to withdraw his Cancellation of Removal (EOIR 42B) application and asked the Immigration Judge for voluntary departure.

On November 25, 2025, Plaintiff's undersigned counsel discovered that ICE was attempting to move Plaintiff out of Virginia in order to deport him back to Honduras. However, due to the filed habeas petition, they were unable to move him.

Plaintiff wishes to retract his previously filed Habeas petition so that he can be deported back to Honduras.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests this Court to retract Plaintiff's previously filed Habeas petition and allow him to be removed from this country.
