Stipulation and Order Requiring Response

On November 3, 2025, petitioner Pablo Aguilar filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus challenging his detention by ICE, (ECF No. 1). For good cause, the Court may set a deadline for the respondents to respond to the petition. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 2243. Accordingly,

IT IS STIPULATED by the parties that:

1. Respondents shall respond to the petition for a writ of habeas corpus no later than November 24, 2025.
2. If petitioner chooses to file a reply, he must do so no later than three

business days after respondents file their response.

3. Petitioner delivered a copy of the petition to the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Eastern District of Michigan by certified mail on November 12, 2025, which constitutes proper service on the U.S. Attorney's Office.
