PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT, pursuant to Local Court Rule 65(b), Petitioner Lien Ngoc Do hereby requests that the Court issue a temporary restraining order directing Respondents to immediately release her from the Northwest Immigration and Customs Enforcement Processing Center in Tacoma, Washington and return her to her prior Order of Supervision.
