**ANSWER TO PETITION FOR WRIT
OF HABEAS CORPUS; SUGGESTION
OF MOOTNESS**

1 On November 20, 2025, Petitioner Gurdip Singh filed a Petition for a Writ of
2 Habeas Corpus (the “Petition”), claiming that his detention without a bond hearing is
3 unlawful and unconstitutional. Dkt. No. 6-1. Because Respondents have requested that the
4 Executive Office for Immigration Review (“EOIR”) schedule a bond hearing for the
5 Petitioner, the Respondents submit that the Petition is now moot and should be dismissed
6 for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. Respondents anticipate shortly filing a supplemental
7 notice updating the Court on the Petitioner’s bond hearing status.

8 Providing the Petitioner with the bond hearing, or otherwise releasing him from
9 detention, moots the habeas petition. *See, e.g., Javier Gonzales et al. v. Kristi Noem et*
10 *al.*, 5:25-cv-02054-ODW-BFM, Dkt. 16 (August 25, 2025 minute order by Hon. Judge
11 Wright, denying as moot the petitioners’ pending request for a preliminary injunction
12 given their receipt pursuant to a TRO of 1226(a) bond hearings and issuing the
13 petitioners an order to show cause re: dismissal); Dkt. 17 (notice of voluntary dismissal);
14 and Dkt. 18 (order dismissing petition). *See also Moises Salomon Zaragoza Mosqueda v.*
15 *Kristi Noem et al.*, 5:25-cv-002304-CAS-BFM, Dkt. 15 (September 17, 2025 minute
16 order by Hon. Judge Snyder, denying preliminary injunction and issuing OSC re
17 dismissal for mootness given the petitioners’ receipt of immigration bond hearings); and
18 Dkt. 16 (notice of voluntary dismissal).

19 This case is no exception. Petitioner’s habeas petition is now moot.

20 Accordingly, Respondent respectfully requests that the Court deny the habeas
21 petition and dismiss the action as moot.
