Respondents' Advisory to the Court Regarding Petitioner's Release

Respondents file this Advisory to notify the Court of Petitioner's order for release from custody of the United States, which action moots this habeas challenge to the legality of his extended detention. *See Bacilio-Sabastian v. Barr*, 980 F.3d 480, 483 (5th Cir. 2020); *Ortez v. Chandler*, 845 F.2d 573, 575 (5th Cir. 1988); *Riley v. I.N.S.*, 310 F.3d 1253, 1257 (10th Cir. 2002); *Virani v. Huron*, 2020 WL 7405655, at *3 (W.D. Tex. Dec. 17, 2020). On or about November 24, 2025, Petitioner brought this habeas claim, seeking release from detention or a bond hearing. ECF No. 1. On December 8, 2025, the immigration judge granted Petitioner's custody redetermination request and ordered that Petitioner be released from custody under a bond of \$1,500.00. Exh. A at 1 (Order of the Immigration Judge (redacted)). Petitioner has now posted bond and is in the process of being released. Consequently, the relief Petitioner sought, namely a bond hearing and order of release, has already occurred. This petition is, therefore, moot.
