1 In an order dated March 17, 2026, the Court directed Respondents to file a notice of compliance
2 with its order granting in part, and denying in part, the petition for habeas corpus. (ECF 15.)

3 Respondents respond as follows:

4 On February 3, 2026, an immigration judge held a bond hearing for Petitioner “pursuant to the
5 Order of the U.S. District Court, Eastern District of California, dated January 16, 2026, requiring the
6 Court to hear the bond request pursuant to section 236(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act.” *See*
7 Exhibit A: order of the immigration judge, dated Feb. 3, 2026. At the hearing, the immigration judge
8 conducted an individualized assessment of Petitioner’s flight risk and dangerousness. *See id.* The
9 immigration judge then denied bond upon finding “that the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has
10 met its burden by ‘clear and convincing’ evidence that [Petitioner] poses an extreme flight risk to justify
11 denial of bond.” *See id.* Attached is a true and correct copy of the immigration judge’s order.¹
