**NOTICE OF CHANGE IN
CIRCUMSTANCES AND
SUPPLEMENTAL FACTS**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE

I petitioner, Nahapetyan Khacho, respectfully submits this Notice to inform the Court of a critical development in my underlying immigration proceedings:

On December 24, 2025, the scheduled Individual Hearing did not result in a decision. The hearing was continued to March 5, 2026. Crucially, this continuance was not requested by me. The delay was caused by the Government/Immigration Court. Perhaps due to the lack of time on the docket or perhaps reduction of Immigration Judges as witnessed by The Los Angeles Times post on December 29, 2025, that more than a quarter of federal Immigration Judges in California have been reduced.

This delay will extend my detention by an additional 70 and more days through no fault of my own. This supports my claim that my detention has become indefinite and unreasonably prolonged in violation of Due Process.

I respectfully request that this Court DENY the Government's Motion to Dismiss and order my release or a bond hearing immediately, as my continued incarceration is not due to any delay tactics on my part.
