**DECLARATION OF

I, Mayra Gallenkamp, make the following statements under oath and subject to the penalty of perjury:

1. I am a Deportation Officer (“DO”) with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”), U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”), Enforcement and Removal Operations (“ERO”), in the Fresno sub-office of the San Francisco Field Office. I have been employed with DHS since March 3, 2019. I currently serve as a DO with the Detained Unit.

2. My responsibilities include but are not limited to, placing aliens into removal proceedings and monitoring case progression, evaluating bond status, and enforcing final orders of removal. I am familiar with ICE policies and procedures governing the detention and removal of aliens who lack lawful immigration status in the United States.

3. I am the DO assigned to the case of Youb Pek (“Petitioner”). The facts in this declaration are based on my personal and professional knowledge, consultation with other DHS and ICE personnel, and reasonable review of official documents, systems, and records maintained by the agency and DHS, and other relevant sources during the regular course of my duties.

4. The Petitioner remains detained at GSA pursuant to INA § 241(a)(6).

5. On January 5, 2026, Petitioner had a virtual nationality interview with the Cambodian Embassy. ICE personnel did not attend the interview. At the conclusion of the interview, ICE emailed
