Johnson, Assistant United States Attorney for said District, pursuant to this Court's Order Denying Ex Parte Motion for Order to Show Cause, Ordering Parties to Confer, Ordering Notice (Dkt. 3), and hereby stipulate and agree to the following briefing schedule and terms.

WHEREAS Federal Respondents agree to not (1) remove Petitioner from this Court's jurisdiction or (2) transfer him from the Northwest ICE Processing Center in Tacoma, Washington, to any other facility while these proceedings are pending, unless transfer is necessary for medical evaluation, treatment or release.

WHEREAS the parties have agreed to a briefing schedule on Petitioner's habeas petition as follows: Federal Respondent's Return shall be due on December 30, 2025, and Petitioner's Traverse shall be due on January 6, 2026.
