1. PENDING CASE

The above-captioned matter is assigned to Honorable Dale A. Drozd, with any referral to Edmund F. Brennan, and bears Case No. 1:25-cv-01920-DAD-EFB.

2. RELATED CASE

3. BASIS FOR RELATEDNESS

This case is related to the above-referenced action within the meaning of Local Rule 123 because the two cases:

- Arise out of the same operative facts and events;
- Involve closely related parties, including spouses;
- Present substantially similar legal and factual issues; and
- Involve overlapping requests for injunctive and/or emergency relief, such that assignment to the same judge would promote judicial economy and avoid inconsistent rulings.

Notably, in the related case filed by Plaintiff's wife, the Court has already granted relief arising from the same underlying facts and circumstances at issue in this action.

4. PRIOR COURT ACTION

On December 23, 2025, the Court entered an Order Granting Temporary Restraining Order in R  M  V Chestnut 1:25-CV-01912-TLN-CKD. A true and correct copy of that Order is attached as Exhibit A.

5. JUDICIAL ECONOMY

Because the related case has already proceeded to substantive relief based on the same factual circumstances, assignment of these matters to the same judicial officer would conserve judicial resources, avoid duplicative proceedings, and reduce the risk of inconsistent rulings.
