Respondents file this Supplemental Advisory to the Court to correct inaccurate information unintentionally provided to the Court. Respondents relied on informational systems and handwritten notes that are normally accurate. Respondents filed redacted documentation with the Court to substantiate the information provided. However, Petitioner's Counsel, Ms. Ana Ionescu, informed Respondents in the evening of March 16, 2026 that Petitioner was not deported.

Immediately upon learning of the information from Petitioner's counsel, Respondents contacted Enforcement Operations to understand what occurred with Petitioner's deportation. Petitioner was released in early afternoon of March 17, 2026. Exh. A (Release Order). Respondents then immediately informed Petitioner's counsel who confirmed the that Petitioner's family is coordinating Petitioner's transportation to his home. Respondents file this Supplemental Advisory to confirm the commitment of candor and transparency with the Court. The undersigned did not intentionally provide inaccurate information to the Court.
