Respondents Notice to the Court

Pursuant to the Court's Order (ECF No. 5 at 2-3), signed and entered on January 21, 2026, the Federal Respondents advise the Court:

Petitioner remains detained; however, on January 26, 2026, he appeared before the Immigration Court for a scheduled bond hearing pursuant to this Court's Order. ECF No. 5 at 2.

The Immigration Judge granted Petitioner a bond and Petitioner was ordered released under a \$8,000.00 bond. *See* Exh. A (IJ Bond Order).
