RESPONDENT'S ADVISORY TO THE COURT

Respondents file this advisory with the Court pursuant to this Court's Order (Dkt. No. 8):

1) On February 9, 2026, Respondents were ordered, to provide Petitioner with a bond hearing before an Immigration Judge, or release Petitioner from custody, under reasonable conditions of supervision, **no later than February 11, 2026**. Dkt. No. 8 at 5.

2) Further, Respondents were directed to file an advisory informing the in detail, of the reasons for the Immigration Judge's bond hearing decision no later than February 16, 2026. *Id.*

3) On February 11, 2026, a custody redetermination was held by the immigration court. *See* Exh. A (IJ Order). The immigration court denied Petitioner's request for a change in custody status, finding that decisions in *Buenrostro-Mendez v. Bondi*, Nos. 25-20496, 25-40701 (5th Cir. Feb. 6, 2026), and *Matter of Yajure-Hurtado*, 29 I&N Dec. 216 (BIA 2025) establish that the court lacks jurisdiction to grant the requested relief. *Id.*

4) On February 13, 2026, the undersigned recommended Petitioner be released from custody in compliance with this Court's order. Dkt. 8. at 5.

5) Petitioner was subsequently released on February 13, 2026.
