Federal Respondents' Status Report to the Court

Federal Respondents file this status report to notify the Court of Petitioner's removal status, per the Court's Order of March 11, 2026. ECF No. 15. The Court ordered Respondents to notify the Court of whether any third country had been identified for Petitioner's removal and the steps taken to obtain travel documents from those countries, and whether circumstances have changed regarding Petitioner's removal to Mexico or Cuba.

As stated in the attached declaration from Guadalupe Tello, Acting Supervisory Detention and Deportation Officer, no third countries have been identified for Petitioner's removal. *See* Exh. A, Declaration, at pg. 2, ¶ 7. Further, on March 6, 2026, ERO El Paso requested an update from the assigned officer acting as a liaison for ICE ERO and the Cuban government, but no response has been received. ERO will continue to work to identify a third country for removal. Regarding the circumstances for removal to Cuba or Mexico, the circumstances have not changes and neither Cuba nor Mexico will not accept Petitioner. To date, Petitioner has not been removed and remains in custody.
