Corrected¹ Federal Respondents' Status Report

Pursuant to this court's order issued on January 23, 2026, ECF No. 5, Respondents file this status report.

On January 28, 2026, Petitioner received a bond hearing pursuant to this Courts Order. ECF No. 5. The immigration court² found Petitioner to be a flight risk and that no bond could mitigate risk of flight. *See* Exh. A (IJ Bond Order). On those grounds the immigration court denied bond. Petitioner reserved the right to appeal the decision, and any appeal would be due within 30 days. *Id.*

² Respondents further advise the Court Petitioner is presently in ICE custody in Laredo, Texas. The custody redetermination (bond) hearing was held in the Laredo, Texas, immigration court. On January 14, 2026, and prior to the Court's Order, Petitioner was transferred from El Paso to another ICE center in Harlingen, Texas. On January 15, Petitioner was transferred from Harlingen, Texas, to the Webb County Detention Center in Laredo, Texas. The Court's Order prohibiting transfer out of the Division and District was issued on January 15, 2026 at 3:29 MST/4:29 CST.

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
