RESPONSE TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Honorable Judge Kathleen Cardone,

My name is Jenny Hallee. I respectfully submit this response to clarify my role and correct any misunderstandings. I am not an attorney. I filed the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus in good faith to assist Kevin Armando Gomez Hernandez, who is currently detained. Webb County Detention Center 9998 S Highway 83 Laredo, TX 78046.

Kevin is the brother of my best friend Silvia Juliana Gomez Hernandez, who also helps care for my daughter. Because of our close family relationship and trust, I felt a moral responsibility to assist him during this difficult time. I have known him personally for several years, and I am sincerely dedicated to his best interests.

Kevin's immigration hearing before Judge Emmanuel Garcias was held on February 5, 2026. At that time, he was given a new hearing date of March 5, 2026. However, the hearing was later moved up to February 19, 2026. This change has reduced the time available for him to prepare his case while detained.

Additionally, Kevin has difficulty seeing and normally wears contact lenses. Since being detained, he has not had proper access to them. He is attempting to obtain prescription glasses through family assistance. His limited vision makes it difficult for him to review documents and prepare legal filings on his own.

To clarify the Court's questions:

1. Kevin first entered the United States on February 2, 2022.
2. Kevin has never previously been detained and released by immigration authorities. This is his first detention.

I respectfully apologize for any misunderstanding and ask the Court to consider these circumstances.
