Federal Respondents' Response to Motion to Amend Ruling

On March 2, 2026, Petitioner filed his motion to amend the ruling under Rule 59(e). *See* ECF No. 11. Petitioner renews his request for release. *Id.* In his motion, the only new factual development is that his special immigration juvenile visa is now current, meaning he can use the visa to apply to adjust status. ECF No. 11 at 2. This doesn't mean the Court should amend the judgment and order Petitioner released as he can apply to adjust status using this visa before the immigration court. His next hearing is March 25, 2026. *See* Automated Case Information System (last accessed Mar. 9, 2026). Petitioner's motion should be denied.
