I hope this letter and the attached documents finds you well.

I am not certain why my filing ("pleadings"...) for the Petition for Bond is not being filed. If you recall, we had two conversations on April 26 and 27 about this being a separate lawsuit/action irrelevant to the Kuck Baxter LLC filing in the **00139 petition for habeas. You already heard my view of the firm's lack of competence and UNNECESSARY threat/harm to my family – to the point that my ten (10) years old had to intervene.

With this letter, I please find three motions and I again beg you to please file them accordingly. I spoke with Ms. Elizabeth (your deputy) this morning – in absence of Mr. Frost (the deputy Clerk handling my cases). She asked me to sent a "Motion to Withdraw Counsel and Proceed Pro Se.". As I explained to her, I had sent that motion the following day after our conversation (when you agreed and filed the Petition for Bond in **00709 case). I am attaching the same herein.

I am also forwarding you two Motions for Emergency Hearing for each of the two cases, since the Six month detention this Court requires is only 17-18 days away, and I am hoping and praying that the Court (Honorable Land) would consider the length of time and the extreme hardship on my young kids.

I appreciate your time and efforts in all these issues. Please bear in mind that I am already suffering from the Stewart Det. Ctr. managers and supervisors misleading us about when the mail goes out, or when they will take our mail from the units to the mail-room, the mail-room delay in processing, taking mail to the USPS, and the USPS's delay in routing and re-routing the mail to Florida or Atlanta, then Macon, before it delivers the same to your office.
