Federal Respondents' Advisal to the Court

Pursuant to this Court's order entered on February 3, 2026, (ECF No. 2), Federal Respondents file this advisory to update the Court regarding Petitioner's custody status. After a review of government records, it appears that Petitioner voluntarily departed from the United States on February 23, 2026, and is no longer in custody. Should the Court require documentation, Respondents may provide so at the Court's request.

Because Petitioner is no longer in custody, his habeas petition is now moot and should be dismissed or denied as moot. *See Bacilio-Sabastian v. Barr*, 980 F.3d 480, 483 (5th Cir. 2020) (habeas relief mooted where noncitizen released from custody); *Ortez v. Chandler*, 845 F.2d 573, 575 (5th Cir. 1988); *Riley v. I.N.S.*, 310 F.3d 1253, 1257 (10th Cir. 2002); *Virani v. Huron*, 2020 WL 7405655, at *3 (W.D. Tex. Dec. 17, 2020).
