**JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS
CORPUS**

Petitioner Arnaldo Seijas Aquino and respondents J.L. Jamison, in his official capacity as Warden of Federal Detention Center – Philadelphia; Brian McShane, in his official capacity as Acting Philadelphia Field Office Director, United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE); Todd Lyons, in his official capacity as Acting Director of Immigration and Customs Enforcement; Kristi Noem, in her official capacity as Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security; the U.S. Department of Homeland Security; and Pamela Bondi, in her official capacity as Attorney General of the United States, move the Court for an order dismissing this matter pursuant to Rule 41(a)(2). Fed. R. Civ. Pro. 41(a)(1)(A).

On February 2, 2026, Petitioner filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus, ECF No. 1, challenging the legality of his detention by ICE. On February 6, 2026,

ICE released Petitioner from custody. Respondents have not yet filed an answer to the petition.

Petitioner and Respondents now move jointly for the petition to be dismissed. Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 5.1.2, counsel for the parties consent to the submission of this motion with their electronic signatures below.
