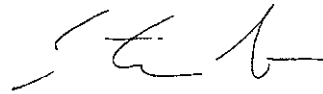
**STATUS REPORT**

Pursuant to the Court's Order of February 18, 2026 (ECF 15), a bond hearing was held in Immigration Court for Petitioner the morning of Friday, February 20, 2026. Despite Respondents providing no evidence of "dangerousness or flight risk", bond was set in the amount of \$10,000.00. Petitioner's friends and family paid the bond later the same day.

As of the date and time of this Status Report, Petitioner is still in detention at Camp East Montana.

Petitioner respectfully requests that in light of Respondents' seeming inability to comply with the orders of this Court and others that this Court order the immediate release of Petitioner, the return to him of all his personal property, and his transportation to the District of Minnesota.
