RESPONDENTS' STATUS REPORT

Respondents file this notice to notify the Court of Petitioner's bond hearing status, per the Court's Order signed on February 18, 2026. ECF No. 15. On February 20, 2026, the IJ granted the petitioner's bond request setting a bond of \$10,000 and alternatives to detention (ATD) at the discretion of DHS. *See* Ex. A ("IJ Order"). ICE is in communications with Petitioner's attorneys from the immigration bond proceeding regarding the proper procedures for posting bond.
