RESPONDENTS' ADVISORY TO THE COURT

Pursuant to the Court's Order (ECF No. 7), signed and entered on March 12, 2026, the Federal Respondents advise the Court:

- 1) On March 12, 2026, Respondents were ordered to provide the Court with an update on the status of the Petitioner's release from custody or status of bond hearing. *See* ECF No. 12.
- 2) On March 20, 2026, Immigration Judge Justin Adams provided a bond hearing to the Petitioner. Exh. A (Bond Order). The bond hearing was two days after the Court ordered the bond hearing to occur. According to information provided by ICE, the agency erroneously believed the bond deadline to be March 23, 2026, instead of March 18, 2026. According to ICE, this was a result of a clerical error on behalf of the agency. Immigration Judge Adams was made aware of this discrepancy but proceeded with the bond hearing under INA § 236. Judge Adams found that the Government met its burden, showing the Petitioner to be a flight risk and denied bond. *Id.*
