Emergency Motion for Temporary Restraining Order

1. I am the biological mother of [REDACTED]. At present, [REDACTED] is placed at Compass Connections, a facility designated for individuals in the custody of U.S. immigration authorities. During the pendency of his asylum application, the alien registration number ("A-Number") used for him is [REDACTED]. In proceedings before this Court, the government may have assigned or may be using a different A-Number for him.

2. The date of birth recorded in official or institutional records as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] is not my son's true date of birth. His father, Weng Wengui, for reasons unrelated to the present matter, intentionally registered my son's age as older than his actual age when completing household registration documentation.

3. As a result, the age reflected in existing records does not represent my son's true biological age. In fact, his actual age is younger than the age currently attributed to him, and he should therefore be considered a minor under the law.

4. I have recently learned that Compass Connections may treat my son as an adult upon his reaching the inaccurately recorded age, and may transfer him to an adult detention facility or place him in an adult shelter.

5. Such actions would be extremely dangerous, unlawful, and severely harmful. Because my son is in fact a minor, placement in an adult detention facility or adult shelter would expose him to serious safety risks, risk of abuse, and other irreparable harm.

6. At present, the facility does not possess any official birth certificate or documentation establishing my son's true date of birth. Until such documentation is formally submitted and verified, any conclusion that my son is an adult would be premature and erroneous.

7. If Compass Connections removes my son from his current minor-appropriate placement before his true age is lawfully verified, such action may constitute unlawful detention of a minor or de facto child abandonment, the consequences of which cannot be remedied.

8. Absent immediate judicial intervention, there is a real and imminent risk that my son will be transferred out of Compass Connections before his age is lawfully confirmed, resulting in irreparable harm.

9. For these reasons, I respectfully request that this Court issue a Temporary Restraining Order prohibiting Compass Connections, the Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR), the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), and any related agencies from removing, transferring, releasing, or reclassifying my son as an adult until his official birth documentation has been submitted and reviewed.
