EMERGENCY MOTION FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE DUE TO MEDICAL AND
MENTAL HEALTH CONDITIONS

COMES NOW, Mia Cristal Guzman Tapia, acting as next friend for the Petitioner, respectfully requesting that this Court order the immediate release of the Petitioner due to serious medical and mental health concerns while detained in immigration custody.

In support of this emergency motion, the following is stated:

1. The Petitioner is currently detained at Stewart Detention Center in immigration custody.
2. The Petitioner has been detained since approximately December 9, 2025.
3. While detained, the Petitioner has experienced significant medical and mental health issues, including abdominal pain, headaches, and chronic physical discomfort for which she has been prescribed medication.
4. In addition to physical symptoms, the Petitioner has suffered severe psychological and emotional distress while detained.
5. According to the Petitioner's testimony, she has experienced depression, anxiety caused by prolonged confinement, severe stress, and symptoms associated with nutritional problems including malnutrition and hair loss.
6. The Petitioner has also reported experiencing discriminatory and hostile treatment inside the detention facility, which has worsened her emotional and psychological condition.
7. The prolonged detention and confinement conditions have significantly affected the Petitioner's physical and mental well-being and continue to pose a serious risk to her health.
8. Continued detention under these conditions may cause further deterioration of the Petitioner's medical and mental health.

9. Given these circumstances, immediate judicial review and humanitarian relief are necessary to prevent further harm.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned respectfully requests that this Court grant this Emergency Motion and order the Petitioner's immediate release or, alternatively, order an expedited hearing to review the legality and conditions of the Petitioner's continued detention.
