PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS (28 U.S.C. §  
2241)

I. INTRODUCTION

Petitioner challenges his unlawful detention by ICE, violating the Fifth Amendment and due process, and interfering with a pending adjustment of status under the Cuban Adjustment Act.

II. JURISDICTION

Jurisdiction arises under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 because Petitioner is in custody in violation of federal law.

III. PARTIES

Petitioner: Adrian Miranda del Valle (A# ) , detained at Bluebonnet Detention Facility, Anson, Texas.

Respondents include DHS Secretary, ICE Director, ERO Dallas Director, and Warden of Bluebonnet.

#### IV. STATEMENT OF FACTS

On December 20, 2025, Petitioner was stopped while driving a commercial truck. ICE detained him without warrant or explanation. His wife and infant U.S. citizen child were abandoned at a gas station. Petitioner has a pending I-485 since April 2023.

#### V. LEGAL ARGUMENTS

1. Due Process violation
2. Unlawful detention
3. Interference with USCIS process
4. No flight risk or danger

#### VI. EMERGENCY MOTION FOR RELEASE

Petitioner seeks immediate release due to constitutional violations and humanitarian concerns.

Immediate release, declaration of unlawful detention, and any other relief.

Please accept for filing the enclosed Emergency Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241, together with a corresponding Emergency Motion for Immediate Release, submitted on behalf of Petitioner Adrian Miranda del Valle, who is currently detained at the Bluebonnet Detention Facility in Anson,

Texas.

This case presents urgent and substantial constitutional concerns. Petitioner is being detained in violation of the Fifth Amendment, having been subjected to a warrantless arrest without any explanation of the legal basis for his detention. The circumstances surrounding his apprehension further involve egregious conduct, including the abandonment of his spouse and minor U.S. citizen child without regard for their safety or welfare.

Additionally, Petitioner has a pending Form I-485 (Application for Adjustment of Status) under the Cuban Adjustment Act, filed with USCIS since April 2023. His continued detention directly interferes with an active and lawful immigration process, further compounding the constitutional violations at issue.

Petitioner is not a flight risk, does not pose a danger to the community, and has demonstrated strong family ties, steady employment, and good moral character. Under these circumstances, continued detention is not only unjustified but constitutionally impermissible.

Given the severity of the violations and the ongoing harm suffered by Petitioner and his family, expedited review is respectfully requested.
