1. I am an adult, competent, and have personal knowledge of the facts herein.
2. I am a Supervisory Detention and Deportation Office with Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO).
3. The petitioner has indicated that they are missing property including a nail gun, social security card, work authorization card and money.
4. ICE officers and attorneys conducted a diligent search of the Petitioner's Alien File (A-File). DHS also reviewed databases relating to custody to identify missing property and any potential location of such property. DHS contacted the custodians at any other locations that Petitioners were detained to inquire about conducting further searching for said location and whether property was located.

5. On March 4, 2026, the social security card was located in El Paso. It is being sent to the Minneapolis ICE office. The tracking number is: . Once received, ICE will inform Petitioner's counsel that the document is ready for pickup. ICE is still actively working on locating the remaining property
