EMERGENCY MOTION FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, FOR  
EXPEDITED HEARING

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Petitioner respectfully files this Emergency Motion and states:

**I. PROLONGED AND UNREASONABLE DETENTION**

Petitioner has now been detained for an extended period exceeding six months. Continued detention without a meaningful opportunity for release is excessive and unjustified under the circumstances.

**II. SEVERE FAMILY HARDSHIP**

Petitioner's continued detention is causing significant hardship to his family. His spouse, who is currently pregnant in the United States, depends on him emotionally and financially during this critical time.

Additionally, Petitioner's parents are in poor health and rely on him for support. His inability to assist them has caused profound distress.

**III. DETERIORATING MENTAL HEALTH**

As a result of prolonged detention and the inability to support his family, Petitioner is experiencing emotional distress and symptoms consistent with depression.

The ongoing confinement and uncertainty are causing serious psychological harm.

**IV. NO JUSTIFICATION FOR CONTINUED DETENTION**

Petitioner has no criminal history, has complied with immigration requirements, and poses no danger to the community or risk of flight. Respondents have failed to provide any individualized justification for continued detention.

V. URGENT NEED FOR RELIEF

Given the prolonged detention and the severe personal and family hardship involved, immediate court intervention is necessary.

VI. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court:

1. Order Petitioner's immediate release; OR
2. In the alternative, order an expedited bond hearing or hearing before this Court.
