PETITIONER’S NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY

Petitioner Roberto Jaime Prado Orozco (Orozco) notifies the Court of a recent decision by the U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, dated April 28, 2026. In *Da Cunha v. Freden*, the Second Circuit held that, as a matter of statutory construction, “Section 1225(b)(2)(A) does not apply to noncitizens, such as Petitioner, who are present in the United States after entering the country without inspection and admission, and who were not apprehended at or near the border at the time of entry.” 2026 U.S. App. LEXIS 12201, at *2 (2d Cir. Apr. 28, 2026). *Da Cunha* supports the arguments in Orozco’s reply in support of his petition for a writ of habeas corpus (ECF No. 5 at 2-4).
