Dear Judge Chen:

This Office represents Respondents in the above-referenced habeas action. Respondents write in accordance with Your Honor's Order dated March 11, 2026, which (1) granted Petitioner's writ of habeas corpus; and (2) directed Respondents to: (a) "release Petitioner from custody immediately and no later than within 24 hours of th[e] Order"; (b) "released Petitioner subject to the conditions at which he was at liberty before he was detained, without any additional constraints on liberty"; (c) "return to Petitioner any and all funds or property seized from Petitioner at the time of his arrest"; and (4) "certify compliance with the Court's Order by filing a letter on the docket no later than 9:00 p.m. . . . [on] March 12, 2026."

This Office is advised by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") that ICE released Petitioner from custody with his property on the afternoon of March 12, 2026, and that ICE understands that Petitioner is subject to the conditions at which he was at liberty before he was detained, without additional constraints on liberty.

Separately, Petitioner's counsel confirmed earlier today that they understand that Petitioner has been released. However, Petitioner's counsel has not yet been able to confirm the return of Petitioner's funds and property.
