PETITIONER'S STATUS REPORT

On March 23, 2026, Petitioner filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus requesting Petitioner be released from custody or in the alternative be afforded a bond hearing based on a violation of his due process rights under Destino and being a member of both Maldonado Bautista and Guerreo Orellana classes.

On March 31, 2026, the Court issued an order granting a bond hearing as soon as practicable and ordering the parties to file a status report by April 10, 2026.

On April 7, 2026, Immigration Judge Christine Olson denied bond stating: "Respondent is a danger to the community by clear and convincing evidence due to serious criminal history involving drug trafficking. In the alternative, the Court finds Respondent a flight risk by a preponderance of the evidence and no amount of bond can ameliorate that risk."
