**OPPOSITION TO NOTICE OF
RELATED CASE**

22 Petitioner has filed a Notice of Related Case pursuant to Local Rule 40.1, asserting
23 that this present action is related to *Fanfan v. Noem*, No. 25-cv-3291-DMS-BJW (S.D.
24 Cal.). Respondents respectfully oppose Petitioner's Notice of Related Case. The
25 government has carefully reviewed this petition and determined that the legal issues
26 presented concern the statutory authority for U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement's
27 (ICE) detention of Petitioner under 8 U.S.C. §§ 1225(b)(2)(A) or 1226(a). The underlying
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1 legal issues and named respondents are nearly identical to those in a vast amount of the
2 habeas petitions that have been filed over the proceeding months in this district, many that
3 have been heard and adjudicated by this Court. *See, e.g., Sobirov v. LaRose*, No. 26-cv-
4 1635-TWR-AHG (S.D. Cal.); *Movlaev v. LaRose*, No. 26-cv-1969-TWR-DDL (S.D. Cal.);
5 *Blanco Sequera v. LaRose*, No. 26-cv-1697-TWR-JLB; *Li v. Noem*, No. 26-cv-1933-TWR-
6 JLB (S.D. Cal.); *Calel-Pelico v. Archambeault*, No. 26-cv-1937-TWR-AHG (S.D. Cal.).
7 Accordingly, Respondents respectfully assert that this present case should remain as
8 presently assigned.
