**STATUS UPDATE TO COURT REGARDING CLOSURE OF CASE
GRANTING PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS**

On April 29, 2026, this Court GRANTED Petitioner's Habeas Corpus Petition and found that the "Petitioner's detention without an individualized bond hearing violates his rights under the Due Process Clause of the Fifth Amendment". (ECF DOC. 12 at 11, ¶ 1(a) Judge John R. Tunheim's April 26, 2026, Memorandum Opinion and Order).

Petitioner Axel J.M.C. submits this Status Update to this Order directing either party "to file an update no later than by 5:00 PM on May 28, 2026, indicating if there is any reason why the Court should not close this matter". (ECF DOC. 19.)

COMES NOW, Petitioner, through counsel, has no reason why this Court should not close this matter. Petitioner is not detained at this current time, and he is

in removal proceedings at Fort Snelling Immigration Court, where he seeks to adjust his status to permanent resident. Petitioner, and undersigned counsels, are comfortable with this matter being closed.
