The Court's order for a response to the habeas petition in this case directed Respondents to "address whether they have complied with the preliminary injunction issued on March 26, 2026 in *Advocates for Human Rights v. U.S. Dep't of Homeland Security*, Civ. No. 26-749." ECF No. 4, at 2. When Respondents filed their response on April 27, 2026, they understood that U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement personnel would complete the Whipple Compliance Form so that the document could be filed with the Court. *See* ECF No. 4, at 9. But ICE has since notified Respondents' undersigned counsel that the agency will not complete the form in this case because Petitioner was not detained or processed at the Whipple Federal Building—he came to the facility for only about 30 minutes on April 23, 2026, to be served with a Notice to Appear.
