STATUS REPORT

On June 18, 2026, the Court ordered Respondents to provide a status report confirming that either confirms that Mr. Nabijon N. (Petitioner) had a bond hearing consistent with 8 C.F.R. § 1003.19(d), or if no bond hearing is provided, immediately release Petitioner no later than 5:00 P.M. on June 26, 2026. ECF No. 11. That same order provided that if no bond hearing was held, Respondents will update the Court concerning the circumstances of Petitioner's release from detention. *Id.*

Counsel for Petitioner contacted the U.S. Attorney's Office with an inquiry whether Petitioner would still receive a bond hearing given his transfer of custody to Hennepin County. The undersigned counsel contacted U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) who relayed to the undersigned counsel that Petitioner was released from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) custody at 9:30 A.M. on June 5, 2026, pursuant to a writ from the Hennepin County District Attorney related to his state criminal case 27-CR-24-18065. The undersigned counsel relayed the same to counsel for Petitioner at 3:07 P.M., in his e-mail response to the initial inquiry on June 18, 2026.

Respondents can no longer hold a bond hearing pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 1003.19(d) for the custody redetermination of Petitioner because Petitioner has been removed from DHS custody. Attached is Petitioner's Detention History, as provided by ICE.
