24 *Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-CV-01873-SSS-BFM, --- F. Supp. 3d ---, 2025 WL
25 3288403 (C.D. Cal. Nov. 25, 2025). The Ninth Circuit later stayed application of the Order
26 beyond the Central District of California. However, Respondents acknowledge the prior
27 orders from this District directing bond hearings pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) in similar
